**Welcome to the Road Race League**  
**We wish you a successful and enjoyable season**

**Race Information. 2012**

- British Cycling ranking points will be awarded in addition to the league points awarded to each competitor.
- A minimum of one league point will be awarded to each rider who finishes a race.
- League points will be awarded in accordance with a points' tariff. A harder course will have more points awarded than an easier one.
- All races will have National Escort trained motorcyclists as well as first aid cover provided by The Red Cross or Manchester Medical Services.
- The league championship will have a Group A champion and a Group B champion.
- Each group championship will be awarded to the rider who receives the highest total of points from his/her best 10 events (or fewer).
- **When a rider moves from Cat 3 to Cat 2 he/she will compete in the Group A races. Any league points awarded to the rider for the Group B races will remain in Group B and not be transferred to Group A. These points will still count for the Group B championship.**
- **Any rider moving from Group B to Group A will start with zero points in the new group.**
- The champion rider, in addition to the prize money, will also receive an inscribed trophy and a championship jersey.
- In addition to the league championship, a season long prime competition will be held whereby prime points will be awarded to the first three riders over the line at the end of each lap for groups A and B respectively. Prime points will not be added to the league championship competition.
- A Grimpeurs Trophy will be awarded to the rider who has the best overall performance in selected hilly events.
- At the end of the season prize money for the prime competition will be awarded to the top 3 riders only from each group
- The winner of the prime competition will also receive an inscribed trophy.
- **When you enter a race you will automatically be put on the signing on sheet. A start sheet will be available on the web site ([www.cdnw.org](http://www.cdnw.org)) for each event. Start sheets will not be sent out. You will be informed if your entry is not accepted for any reason.**
- No event will be cancelled, unless safety requirements are compromised.
- **All registered riders (or their helpers) are required to marshal one event. This is critical to the success of all the races, please inform me if you are unable to marshal at your designated event.**
- **A registered rider will receive 30 league points when his/her marshalling duty has been completed. If a rider fails to complete a marshalling duty without just cause 30 league points will be deducted from their league total.**
